Applicant Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

- membership in the Meridian FFA,
- be a graduating high school senior,
- academic standing requirements.

Immediate family and/or members of the Dairy Board and Selection Committee are not eligible to participate.

Academic Standing

- The applicant must be a graduating High School senior who maintained a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
- Applicant's scholastic average is to be reported on the application and verified on the submitted transcript.

Meridian FFA Membership Requirement

- The applicant must have been/is a member in good standing of the Meridian FFA Association.
- Membership must be verified by a Meridian FFA Advisor.

Collegiate Acceptance/Enrollment

- The applicant must enroll in an accredited post-secondary institution.
- The applicant must indicate the school, choice of major and career planned.
- No application will be accepted from a student who has not applied for admission by scholarship application due date.

Activities

• Leadership potential and character of the applicant should be demonstrated through the applicant's responses to the categories of the application detailing school, extracurricular, and community activities and achievements.

Narrative

- Each applicant must include a typed narrative (no more than two, 8 1/2" x 11" sheets), double-spaced. The applicant's name and address must be typed as a heading to the narrative in the upper right-hand corner of page one.
- The narrative may include, but is not limited to, the following:
 - brief life story
 - the impact of participation in FFA and other organizations on his/her growth and development as a young adult
 - o any information that he/she feels is pertinent to their career goals
 - o importance of a college education in meeting these goals

References

- Each applicant may submit a maximum of three (3) letters of personal reference from persons who are well acquainted with the applicant.
- References may either be typed or handwritten and should include the name, address and daytime phone number of the person making the recommendation, as well as an indication of the person's relationship to the applicant (teacher, minister, employer, relative, etc.). Please include these letters to the application. No letter should exceed two pages in length.

Evaluation Procedure

For the purposes of evaluation of applicants, the Dairy Board has appointed a Scholarship Selection Committee to review all properly completed applications. The Scholarship Selection Committee will make final approval and notification of the scholarship recipient.

Payment of Stipend

- It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to notify the Dairy Board with the following information:
 - o address of the Financial Aid Office of the College or University
 - class Schedule
 - o student ID number
- This notice must be given to the Board a minimum of thirty (30) days prior to the beginning of each semester or asap.
- Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the Financial Aid Office.
